WHAT I NEED TO KNOW AS A CWC VOLUNTEER – Your FAQs Answered

1. What are the volunteer requirements?

- **Age**
 - ✓ 17–23 years old
- **Language**
 - ✓ Proficient in English
 - ✓ Kiswahili is an added advantage
- **Travel Documents**
 - ✓ Valid passport (minimum 1-year validity from your departure date)
 - ✓ Valid visitor visa via: <https://etakenya.go.ke> (CWC can provide an invitation letter upon request)
- **Health & Medical**
 - ✓ Required vaccinations: Yellow Fever, Hepatitis A, Polio, Typhoid, COVID
 - ✓ This is a Malaria zone - please consult your GP or travel nurse
 - ✓ Carry necessary medications and personal prescriptions
 - ✓ Inform CWC of any existing medical conditions, allergies, disabilities, or special needs (confidential and only used for safety)
- **Travel Arrangements**
 - ✓ Return air ticket or transport to/from Nairobi
 - ✓ Comprehensive insurance: Health | Travel | Medical | Equipment (if applicable) | Flying (if applicable)
- **Documentation**
 - ✓ Completed CWC Volunteer Registration Form
 - ✓ Statement of Understanding
 - ✓ Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Form

- Confirmation:** Upon acceptance, you'll receive a welcome email with all necessary information.
- Orientation:** Attend a day's orientation session upon arrival for to familiarize yourself with our projects and protocols.

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

1. I understand that I should not carry large sums of money around nor leave my personal belongings unattended. I also understand that Community and Wildlife Conservation (CWC) will not be responsible in any way for my personal belongings in the event of such loss or theft.
2. I have familiarised myself with the CWC Emergency Contacts and will always keep a copy of these numbers with me whilst off site.
3. I understand the CWC policy on alcohol abuse and the disciplinary procedures ensuing. I know that the evening before carrying out any project work, I am required to drink responsibly. I agree not to smoke in areas that are not designated smoking zones, or in the rooms at the accommodation at any time. I understand if I am caught by CWC staff taking illegal drugs I will be sent home. If I am caught using illegal drugs by the police or partake in illegal activities, I can be sent to jail. CWC and its affiliates will not be liable for my misdemeanour or bail if these actions were not directly involved with CWC and my volunteer work.
4. I agree to not receiving visitors on site without approval. I am aware about the repercussions of casual sex, including STDs, HIV/ Aids, bed bugs, etc.
5. I understand the conservative dress code guidelines and will not take offence if staff ask me to change while on the field or conducting my volunteer work.
6. I know that whilst I am off site I must remember that I am an ambassador of CWC. I therefore need to conduct myself well throughout my time in Kenya, including the weekends. It is important that I act sensitively and respectfully towards all the people I meet.
7. I agree not to purchase products made/ obtained from any wildlife or any endangered/ protected species. I also agree to using the water sparingly, water is a precious commodity.
8. I understand that I am responsible for covering any costs incurred while booking extra activities, and/or safaris and expeditions that are not included in the CWC volunteer package.

Disclaimer: By signing this document, I agree to having read and understood the above statement. I understand the importance and purposes of these established practices. I recognise they are for my own safety and that failure to adhere to them could place me in jeopardy. I agree to abide by the policies and procedures and understand that I will be volunteering at my own risk and that Community and Wildlife Conservation (CWC), its employees and affiliates cannot assume responsibility for any liability, accident or injury that may occur during my volunteership. RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK & INDEMNITY FORM



In consideration of permitting me, (Name) to travel in and outside of Community and Wildlife Conservation (CWC) and my volunteership operation in the state of Kenya, beginning on (date) to (date) for myself, my personal representatives and my next of kin.

I hereby acknowledge that all forms of travel are a potentially dangerous activity and involve the risk of serious injury and/or property damage. I understand that travel in general may involve sites that are remote, either by time, distance or both from a rescue and/or medical facility.

I hereby release, waive, discharge and agree not to sue CWC, or any of its employees, from all liability to myself, my personal representatives, heirs and next of kin, for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to my person or pro-party or resulting in my death, and any claims or demands therefore on account of participation in travel activities (or any other CWC operation that may occur) whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.

I hereby assume full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury/death or property damage, now and forever, arising out of related travel, whether foreseen or unforeseen and whether caused by negligence of the releases or otherwise.

I hereby separately agree to indemnify and save hold harmless the releases from my loss, liability, damage or causes that may incur, now and forever, arising out of any related CWC operation, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise. I hereby acknowledge that injuries received may be compounded or increased by negligent rescue operations or procedures of the released and agree that this Waiver and Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by releases, including negligent rescue operations and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the Province or State in which the activities are conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall not notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I have read this Waiver & Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, am aware of its legal consequences, and have signed it freely and voluntarily without any inducement, assurance, or guarantee being made to me and intend my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by the law. I have had the opportunity to personally discuss with CWC the potential dangers incidental to my travel arrangements.
